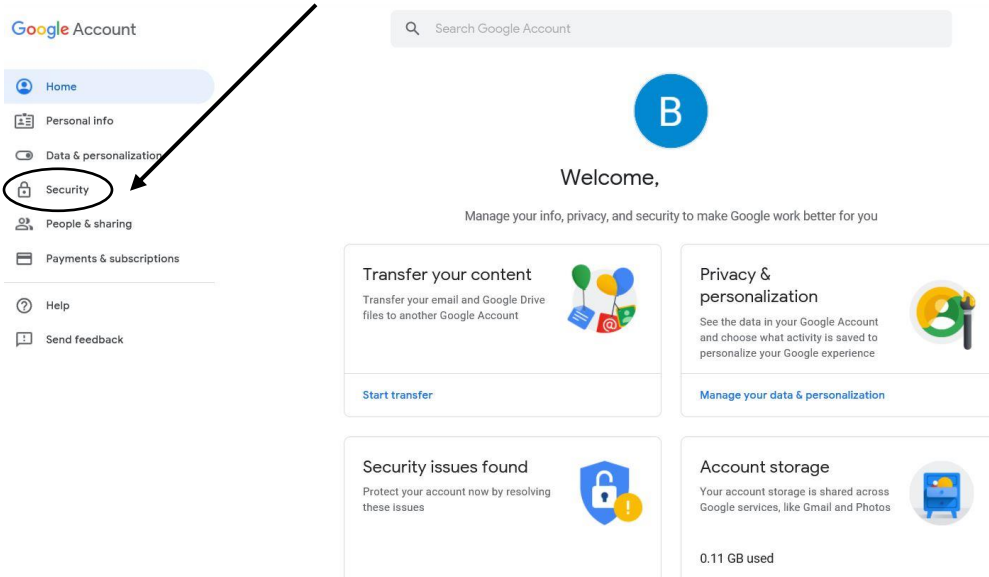
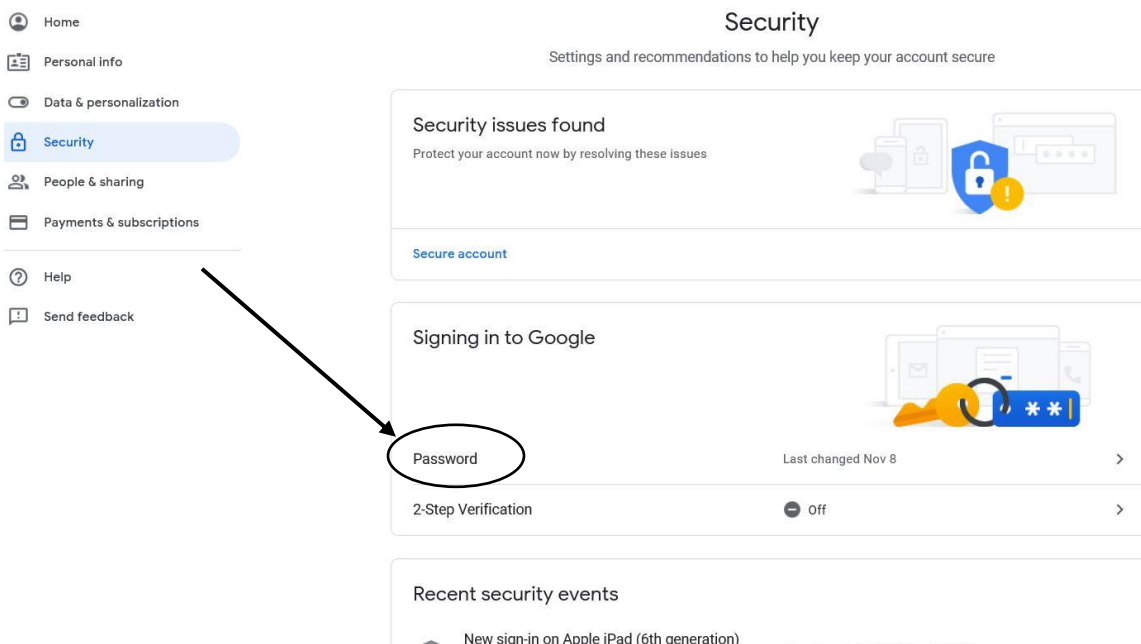


Resetting your Email Account password:


1. Navigate to: myaccount.google.com
2. Navigate to “Security” on the left hand column



3. Under “Signing in to Google” navigate to “Password”



4. In order to reset the password, you'll need to login with your current account credentials


